Health Food Political Party

VOTE HEALTH FOOD: Vote for politicians who eat health food, and avoid alcohol, smoking, drugs. Beware: Alcohol plus politics equals problems.

HAVE POLITICAL PARTIES IN YOUR HOME: Pray, serve fruit and vegetable juices, play music, have fun, and exchange religious, health, and political information.

IDEAS BEFORE MONEY: Get a sheet of paper, and put your basic beliefs into writing. Collect information to back up your beliefs. Put your basic beliefs ahead of the money you earn, the money you spend, and the politicians you vote for.

PRAY FOR "FIRE FROM HEAVEN": May it burn all spiritual, cultural, economic and political garbage out of everything, and empower all citizens who believe they are in the image of God, and willing to promote the will of God on earth as in heaven.

PROMOTE ALCOHOL-FREE BARS : Everyone needs a place to go for health food and socializing, and to find out what's going on in politics. Every well intentioned political candidate, win or lose, could have an alcohol-free bar as a political base.

ADOPT-A-POLITICIAN: Send information. One anti-abortion group had 300,000 members. If each member gave one dollar a year, that's \$300,000. One hundred dollars per year equals \$30,000,000, equal to some of the biggest lobbying groups anywhere.

BASIC POLITICAL DOCUMENTS: Make sure there is a copy of the Ten Commandments on the wall of your home and wall of your favorite religious institution. Get a copy of the U.S. Constitution, Bill of Rights, and Declaration of Independence.

RUN A "PRETEND" CAMPAIGN: When you get together with friends, at your health food political parties, run a "pretend" campaign, and let everyone know your platform.

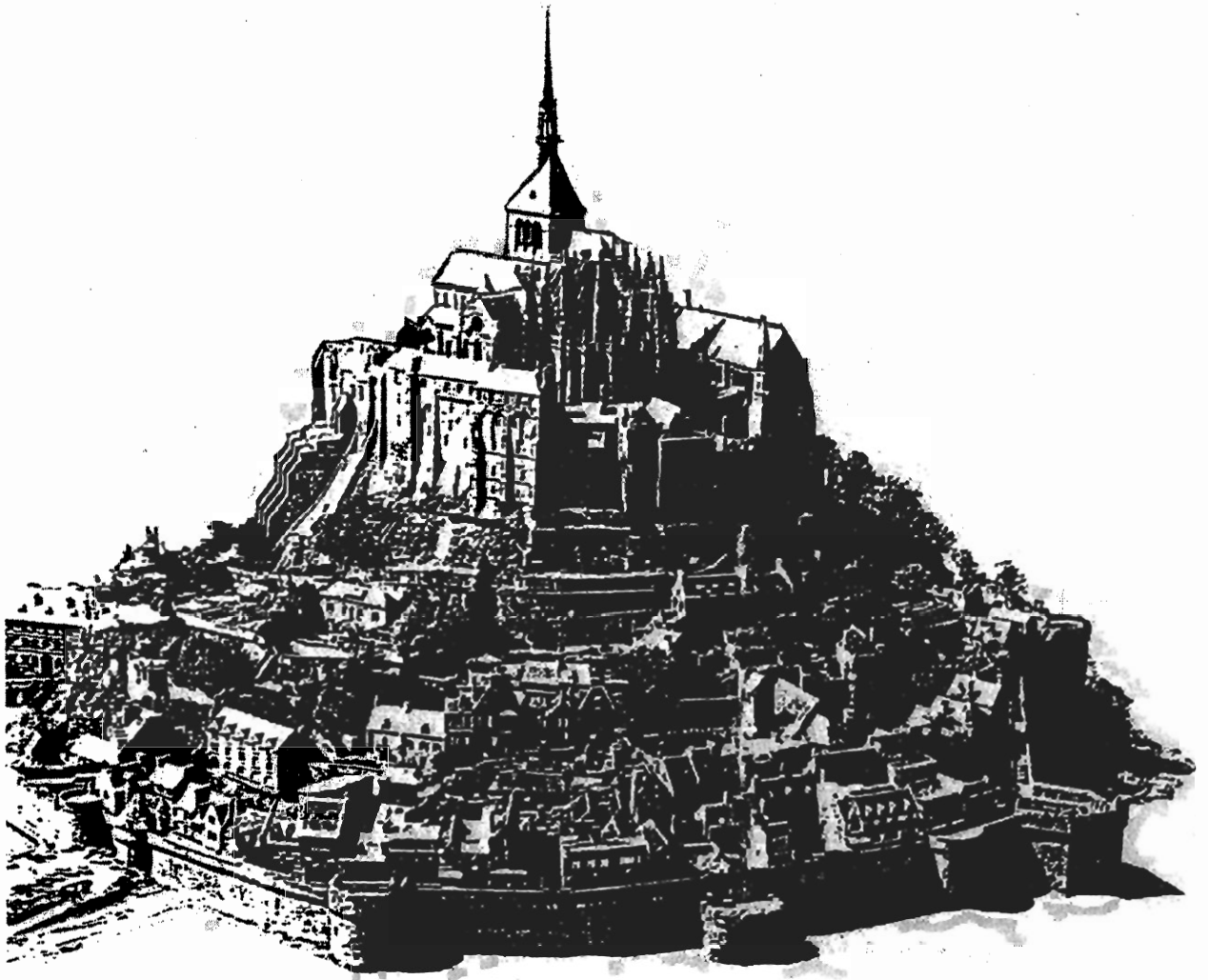

“...the Lombard invasion (568). It was the beginning of the so-called dark ages, a period of large-scale migrations – first the Goths, Lombards, Vandals and Huns, and then the Moors in the west, the Vikings in the north, the Slavs and Magyars in the east – which lasted until the 11th century and made stable government almost impossible. (Charlemagne’s empire represents a brief respite, but he was continually at war on one frontier or another.) In such conditions, the tightly knit, disciplined, self-supporting communities following the Benedictine Rule were able to survive better than any other social unit.”

THEORY: Social power is like a magnet: Power at the “top” of society (big business, government) must be balanced, by necessity, with power at the “bottom” of society: families, extended families, small businesses, local communities...

AMISH, MENNONITES, HUTTERITES: Are good examples, and have survived for hundreds of years. Drawbacks include low use of technology, advantages include stable families, freedom from debt, home and farm ownership.

JEWISH KIBBUTZ: Are an excellent example of religious-cultural-tribal--nationalism. With four percent of the population, at one time they contributed nearly fifty percent of the political leaders.

CATHOLIC MONASTERIES: Have impressive real estate, massive worship centers and fortress-like buildings. Were the safest places to live for hundreds of years during the Middle Ages. A major drawback is a prohibition against marriage.

CATHOLIC OPUS DEI AND MONDRAGON: These are lay communities, with housing and employment. They generate billions of dollars. Millions of people worldwide would be eager to join the security of such communities if given a chance.

GATED COMMUNITIES, TOWNHOUSES AND CONDOMINIUMS: Have a variety of forms. A co-housing version is popular in Europe, with private houses around a community center. Beware, some condo associations are a nuisance.

BACK-TO-THE-LAND COMMUNITIES: Some of these are working OK, and are often also involved with food coops. However, beware of any lingering hippie influence, where drugs and free sex blew some of these groups away from within.

BEWARE MINI-DICTATORS: Leaders should empower members, rather than swindle them. Always give members an easy way out, to protect their investment.

THERE IS POWER IN A GROUP: Like a sports team, like the ancient families-clans-tribes, like the fortified city states down thru history, teamwork increases power.

Action models: Go, go, go!

Citizen priesthoods:

NEW TESTAMENT PRIESTHOOD: Says we are all members of a “royal priesthood”, if we are right before God, so a priesthood can be an attitude of mind before God, rather than something conferred by an existing organization.

WHY HAVE A PRIESTHOOD? A lot of people may drift along in life, without caring about what is really going on. For those who make an effort, who cross a line of “Seek and you shall find”, it may be useful to use the word “priesthood”.

WHAT DOES A PRIESTHOOD MEAN? A useful definition is that a priest or priestess is someone who is committed to having or finding a set of beliefs which they believe will explain and improve the cosmic situation in which we are living.

CAN MEMBERS OF THE PRIESTHOOD MARRY? Yes. Temples of God promotes a married priesthood for itself. “Marriage is honorable.”

CAN THE PRIESTHOOD BE INVOLVED IN PARTISAN SOCIAL ISSUES? Yes. They should just be careful to be respectful of others.

PRIESTHOOD REQUIREMENTS FOR TEMPLES OF GOD: Every religion may have their own standards, but for Temples of God, in its beginning phases, with no existing organization, any priest or priestess should follow these principles:

- Get right with God.
- “Pray without ceasing.”
- Eat health food.
- Collect and read a lot of books.
- Promote self and social improvement.
- Research living at higher dimensions.
- Join with like minded people,
Or form your own organization at some future time.
- Work for “God’s will on earth as in heaven.”
- Explore what it means to be “In the image of God.”

SUPPOSE WE MAKE A LIST OF THE BEST THINGS FROM A WIDE RANGE OF OFTEN COMPETING RELIGIONS AND PHILOSOPHIES:

Suppose we consider a few of the best ideas from each system, and avoid the worst of past and current systems. Certain things, breathing air, drinking water, eating health food, should be common to all social groups, so let's see if we can add a few more:

PURITANS: Work ethic...

Money out of thin air: Any group which can organize around an honest leader can create money "out of thin air"...

CATHOLIC OPUS DEI:

Community...

HINDUISM: Study of symbols...

CHINESE CULTURE: The Great Wall...

SHINTOISM: Nationalism...

BUDDHISM: Large monasteries, nationalism...

ZOROASTRIANISM: Members only temples...

MOSLEM SUFFIISM: Skilled work ethic, no alcohol or drugs...

BLACK TRIBES OF AFRICA:

Basic common sense in organization...

RUSSIAN COMMUNISM:

"Soviets", workers councils (without the violence)...

NATIONAL SOCIALISM: "Volk-state", nationalism (without the violence). Was similar in its goals with Zionism, which could have been a natural ally, if big money had not hired provocateurs to create the conflict...

ANCIENT STONE CULTURES:

Large stone buildings...

ANCIENT EGYPTIANS: Great Pyramid, with dynamic geometry...

GHENGIS KHAN: Respect for the average soldier on horseback (without the violence). Had the largest empire in world history...

OTHER COMMUNITIES: Food coops, back to the land, survivalism, environmentalism, special interest...

MUSIC INDUSTRY: High energy music (better words needed)...

TEMPLARS: Massive architecture, temples, fortresses...

"Cul-de-sac the city"

"Mayor... Daley says he wants to block off streets in every ward as a way of discouraging criminals...

"...building concrete barriers at strategic points of entry to neighborhoods.

"...we're going to cul-de-sac the city - all the wards.

"...the cost would be small.

"...would seek support in each ward before setting up the barricades...

"In a city that is already... among the most segregated..."

For "discouraging criminals", action for town planning.

World-wide economics:

GOD FIRST: Seek God, morals, a work ethic, and basic honesty before money. A culture of honesty is a necessity for a functional economic order. "Seek first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness, and all these things shall be added unto you."

HEALTHY NATIONAL CULTURE: In some cultures, greed, crime, and bribery are so common everyone tends to end up poverty stricken, or with a few rich and many poor. You must work to change the culture. "Righteousness exalts a nation."

SMALL BUSINESSES: Eighty percent of new jobs in the USA are from small businesses, and most of those are in a few states that encourage small business. "Do your own business... Work with your own hands... that you may walk honestly..."

PLANT FRUIT TREES WORLD-WIDE: Half the world's population is in farming. Most of the other half can at least plant fruit trees. "And the Lord God... put him in the garden to dress it and to keep it." Genesis 2:15

GET KNOWLEDGE: "By knowledge shall the chambers be filled with all... pleasant riches." Just giving people money does not make them wealthy. Ninety percent of lotto winners are broke in ten years.

WORK ETHIC: Societies where members tend to stay constructively active, whether or not there is any outside financial system to pay them "money", will always tend to be wealthier. "If any would not work, neither should he eat."

CONSTRUCTIVE USE OF LEISURE: One study claimed that if you give people wealth with leisure, all they do is get into trouble. Know learn how to use leisure. "In his laws does he meditate day and night... and whatsoever he does shall prosper."

WEALTH ATTITUDE: With a wealth attitude, people can attract wealth where little existed before. "The thoughts of the diligent tend only to plenteousness."

ORGANIZE FOR POWER: People who are organized tend to have more wealth and power. "Rulers of thousands, rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens."

MULTI-GENERATIONAL PLANNING: Thinking of others can be motivating. "A good man leaves an inheritance for his children's children."

Get a plan and work it.

More economic theory:

MONEY OUT OF THIN AIR: Banks that print money or make unsecured loans, people that barter, give credit or have an I.O.U., have just created wealth out of thin air. On farms, plants and animals create wealth out of thin air, where none was there before.

THERE ARE MANY FORMS OF WEALTH: Spiritual, emotional, health, cultural, psychological... "I desire that you prosper and be in health even as your soul prospers."

NATIONAL ECONOMIES: National economies (including the USA until 1980) have a balance of farming, manufacturing, and a service economy. They are also the most middle class, and also tend to be religious, tribal, ethnic and predominately race based.

INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION: BASIS OF THE MIDDLE CLASS: The industrial revolution in the 1500's has given rise to the middle class in Europe and later the USA for the past 500 years. It has tended to work largely within national economies.

FRIEDRICH LIST, NATIONALIST AND MIDDLE CLASS THEORETICIAN: An economic theorist in the 1800's who promoted economic nationalism and a middle class thru livable wages for workers. His theories have been adopted by the "Asian tigers."

ADAM SMITH AND KARL MARX, FEUDALISTIC THEORETICIANS: Adam Smith and Karl Marx, from the 1800's, were hired by British bankers to promote free trade for a corporate or a government run plantation for low wage workers. Avoid them.

BEWARE: FEUDALISM: It's a plague of world society for thousands of years, a society with a few rich, many poor, and a small middle class. The rich tend to be alcoholic, arrogant and abusive, promoting endless wars, swindle, oppression...

TRIBAL-NATIONALISM VERSUS MULTI-CULTURALISM: Any size social order with one predominate religious-ethnic-racial-or-cultural group tends to have greater prosperity and lower crime, versus multi-culturalism, with its crime and endless swindles.

EMPHASIZE SMALL BUSINESSES OVER LARGE CORPORATIONS: Local economies survive better, and show more respect to workers. Let large corporations re-organize as franchises with local ownership whenever and wherever possible.

REPLACE STOCK MARKETS WITH LOCAL AND WORKER OWNERSHIP: Abolish the stock market, the greedy amoral incentives equal national oblivion. Break-up all mass media into local ownership. Nationalize the Federal Reserve.

Keep working your plan.

Principles of law:

GEMSTONE LAWS: A well written law should glimmer like a gemstone, rather than smell like a pile of garbage.

HEALTHY POLITICS: As much as possible, political office should be limited to people who eat health food, with no alcohol, smoking, or drugs.

LINE-ITEM VETO: The chief executive - the governors or president - should have line item veto on all law, for further checks and balances.

CITIZEN LEGISLATORS: Citizens should vote mostly for non-lawyers for political office. A lawyer-legislator creates a conflict of interest -- the temptation to write complicated laws that make work for lawyers.

RECORDED VOTES: All votes on all laws should be recorded, and all legislators should be required to vote on all legislation (yes-no-abstain). If the citizens have to keep the laws, they need to know who voted for it, and why.

SINGLE SUBJECT LAW: All laws should have a single subject, with no amendments that have nothing to do with the main subject of the law -- to avoid who knows what, that the citizen is expected to know all about and to keep.

LINE-BY-LINE VOTING: All legislation should be voted on sentence by sentence (using computers), to make sure the legislators have read the law, and to avoid the common practice of sneaking bad law into other legislation.

'MANAGEMENT BY TENS' BUREAUCRACY: Each manager should have at least ten employees, and the number of layers from top to bottom should be a maximum of six layers. Exodus 18:21. (Japan has six layers, the USA up to 50.)

CITIZEN REVIEW OF ALL LAWS: All laws should be reviewed by citizen juries -- a court review -- to search for violations of the Constitution, contradiction of other law, excessive verbiage, or special privileges.

ENGLISH COMMON LAW VERSUS 'BABYLONIAN' COMPLEX LAW: Common law is designed to be understandable by the average citizen. 'Babylonian' complex and contradictory law is designed so lawyers can twist it any way they want.

Run for office if you can.

Central National Bank

BANKING THEORY: Whoever controls the central bank of a nation tends to have massive control over the nation, unless the nation is healthy enough to be organized to a high degree at the local level, so that society is not dependent on any central banks.

THEORY: A Central National Bank replaces the private Federal Reserve, and is set up by the Treasury Department. It is presided over by a Federal judge with a ten year term, and a committee representing each state. It is a fourth branch of government.

CENTRAL NATIONAL BANK: Loans or prints money out of thin air, partially backed by gold or silver, in sufficient amount to minimize both inflation and deflation, keeps all government money and tax receipts, tells Congress what is available to spend, loans money to central state banks, reducing taxes with the interest income.

CENTRAL STATE BANKS: Keep all state money and taxes, and loan money to county banks, reducing state taxes...

POWERS OF COUNTY BANKS: Keep county money and taxes, make loans to citizens, with decisions made by elected juries, with interest reducing county taxes...

BALANCE OF POWERS: Various government, religious, and private banks and credit unions are allowed to compete with each other, to maintain a balance of power.

DISCLAIMER: If the nation is basically healthy and sober, almost any system of economics and politics will work, although some are preferable. If the politicians and public use alcohol and drugs, almost any system will end up in swindle overdrive.

FOR CENTRAL BANKS: LOANS VERSUS NEW PRINTED MONEY: If money is "loaned" into circulation, the bankers can control where the money goes, as well as keep inflation to a minimum, since the loan must be paid back. Money which is "spent" into circulation increases the money supply, and tends to increase inflation.

A balance of powers: Promote local banks...

Bill of Responsibilities

GET RIGHT WITH GOD: You are in the image of God. Look for true love and higher dimensions...

KEEP YOURSELF HEALTHY: Promote health food, positive thinking, moderate exercise, no alcohol, smoking, or drugs...

GET KNOWLEDGE, WISDOM, AND UNDERSTANDING: Study. Promote optimum education. Balance religion and science...

MAINTAIN HIGH BUSINESS ETHICS: Honesty, respect, middle class economics. Keep the Ten Commandments.

PROMOTE MARRIAGE: One male, one female, one mate for life ideal. With a balance of love and morals...

PROMOTE FAMILY TERRITORIES: Family homes, farms, and businesses -- as a way of life, world-wide...

PROMOTE VARIOUS FORMS OF NATIONALISM: Similar to biological nations found in some animals. Territorial definition helps optimize the gene pool, minimizes war, solves a lot of social problems, such as ex-Yugoslavia...

ESTABLISH A "MAGNETIC" POWER-BASE: One pole of the magnet includes families and local organizations, and the other pole includes large organizations and government.

PROMOTE A HEALTHY CULTURE: Culture can be a high energy force field with higher dimensions in music, art, architecture, mass media, stories to children, entertainment, education... For the glory of God...

PROTECT THE ENVIRONMENT: Plant fruit trees, promote solar and wind-energy, high mileage cars, energy efficiency, garden communities, world-wide...

BEWARE OF RIP-OFFS: Especially when alcohol and drugs are around, there are those who will exploit any social weaknesses. Do your homework...

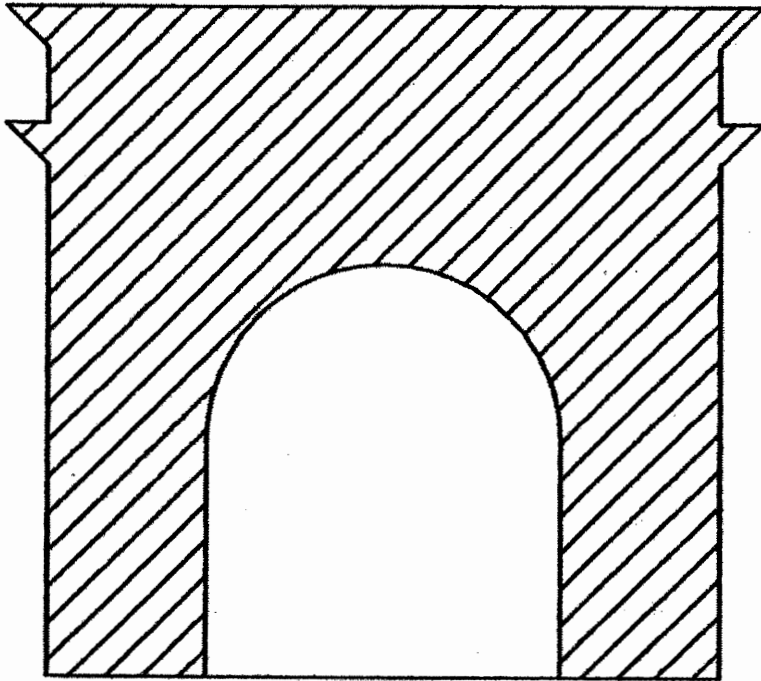

ANYTHING FURTHER IS LIKE TRUE LOVE: Others can tell you it is there, but it is between you and the Higher Powers to find it for yourself.

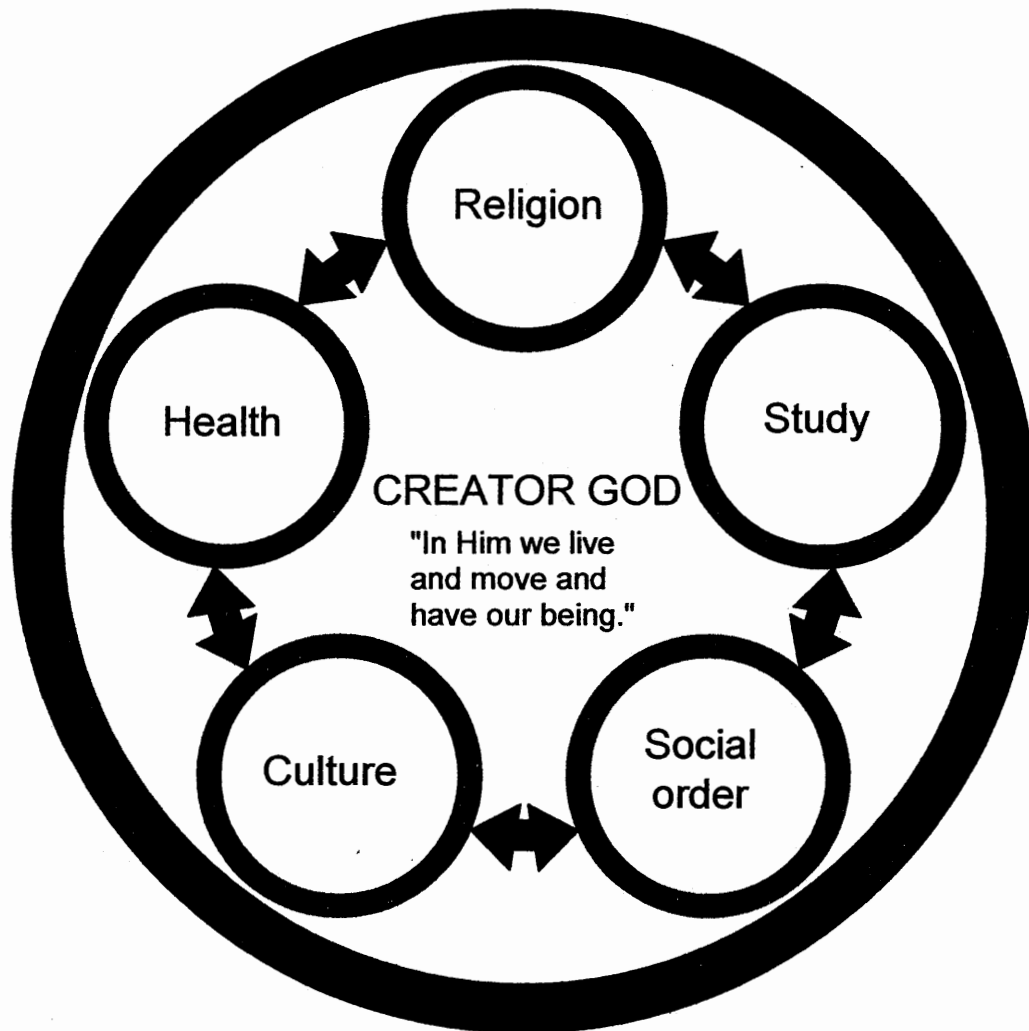
HIGHER DIMENSIONS ARE OUT THERE: Find them if you can.
